

Dear Parent/Guardian of Summer Camper:

We are so excited to welcome your child to Omaha Children's Museum Summer Camp! This summer, campers will have a chance to explore new worlds, invent, and even create their own science shows! There are a lot of exciting new exhibits at the museum; from our summer exhibits, Enchanted Kingdom and Attic Adventures, to our newly renovated Grass Patch, Omaha Children's Museum will provide the perfect backdrop for your child's summer experience!

Each day of camp, your child will experience many hands-on activities, as well as make new friends and have the opportunity to explore the museum! Each day, campers will be provided with a snack. Additionally, there are some activities that may use food-based products. If your child has allergies, please be sure to mark it on your medical form so that teachers are aware and can make arrangements.

Throughout the summer, we will have two evenings where camp families are invited for a special night of play at the museum. You will be able to meet your camp teachers, explore your classrooms, and have a memorable night of play at OCM. We hope you can join us either **June 13th** or **July 11th** from 5:30-7:30 p.m. Please RSVP at ocm.org or find the link included to this email.

On the first day of camp, please park in the lot and bring your camper in to check-in. For each subsequent day, you may drop campers off at our 20th street entrance, using the bus lane. Camp Counselors will be outside waiting to check-in. When picking up your camper, please pull alongside the bus lane at the 20th street entrance. **Have your ID ready.** Campers will **not** be allowed to leave with anyone whose ID does not match the name of an adult listed on their release forms in the authorized pick-up section. If you are not sure who you have listed, you are welcome to call and check with Mary (see contact information below).

Please make sure your phone is on and you are available to contact in the case of an emergency. Please also alert your emergency contacts if you are made unavailable.

If your child is attending Before or After Camp Care, the doors for Before Care will open at 7:45am and pick up for After Care is by 5:15pm. If your child is an all-day camper, **please bring a lunch**, and our staff will facilitate additional games and fun during our Lunch Care hour. If you have signed your child up for lunch care in addition to a half day camp, please come into the museum to drop off or pick up your child. If you would like to sign your child up for additional camp care, please do so in person or call (402) 342-6164 ex. 432. Please note that our office hours are 8:30-6:00 Monday – Saturday and 10:30 – 6:00 on Sunday. Extra care can be added within these times.
